lumber mill.

Anderson, Mrs. No further identification. I was not able to find an Anderson who died on this date (4 Oct 1936) in findagrave,

Ancestry or the LDS site. It couldn't be Ingrid Anderson (above), because she was alive in 1940.

Atwell, Delbert Atwell family, neighbors. *Humboldt Historian*, Spring 2000, page 5. Was hurt on 30 Apr 1935.

Bartlett, Mr. Had an accident in his truck on 11 Oct 1933. No indication of which Bartlett this was.

Batini, Mrs. Charles "Killed" 11 Nov 1934. Another woman was killed going to her funeral.

Bonstell, Olive F. Died 10 Feb 1936. Mrs. Olive F. Clark Bonstell, widow of Edgar Bonstell, per findagrave.com and the California

Death Index.

Borneman, Henry John Died 10 Oct 1935. See https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/24308915/henry-john-borneman

Borneman, Karl Karl A. Borneman, named as a salesman in a grocery store in the 1930 Census. He was born in Iowa; his wife,

Anna Lucinda was born in Nebraska. They had three children in 1930. From Apr 1935 memo: "Carl Borneman got

out of the Super Market [on April 2] as they sold out to the Safeway."

Bray, Mrs. Identity unknown. Buried on 11 Sept 1936.

Breeden The Tiverton was sold to him for junk on 21 Jan 1933. Probably Frank Breeden, who owned an iron & scrap

business.

Buddy Edna received a valentine from him on 13 Feb 1936.

Burger, Gladys Edna received a letter from her 9 Feb 1933. She was 18 on 23 May 1935 and married Mike Burger on 18 May

1935.

Carter, Fred Died 3 Jun 1933, shot by Tom Slaughter, 55 years old at time of death, per California Death Index, 1950-1939.

Champi, Eva Her mother (Benesia Matilda Blandini Adorni) died on 23 Dec 1934.

Chappel, Sally Died 18 Jan 1935, per diary.

Church Mathers, Clara Janett Edna's aunt, and probably Edna N.'s sister. Married to Homer Mathers on 17 July 1905 per marriage certificate.

Born 14 Jan 1884, per diary.

Cloney, Gerald O. Drowned at Carlotta on 2 June 1935. Age 24 per California Death Index, 1905-1939. Buried on 5 Jun 1935.

Clow, Mrs. Very ill on 24 April 1935 and expected to die soon. Died 28 April 1935.

Clyborne, W.F. W.F. Clyborne, aged 79, per California Death Index, 1905-1939. Died 5 Apr 1934. According to the 1920 Census,

he was a lawyer with his own office and married to Jennie Clyborne. He married Jennie V. Gage in Eureka on 8

September 1887 (California County Marriages, 1850-1952).

Cole, Creswell C. Died in a plane crash at Walker's Point on 30 Sept 1935. He was from San Mateo.

Compton, Mr. Died on 18 Jan 1935. Lived on E Street in Eureka

Conti, Mr. Died in San Francisco on 16 Jan 1935.

Cookson, Mrs. Died on 7 May 1935.

Cooper, Dr. Dentist

Crowe, Clarence F. Died of kidney trouble on 14 Jun 1933 at 5:30. Clarence lived with his uncle, Truman Taylor, per the 1930 Census.

Death Index, 1905-1939.

Daley, Edwin Daley was born today."

Daley, Mrs. Broke her hip bone in two places, a week before 11 March 1935.

Dalton, Mr. Arthur Dalton, born in Eureka on 25 Aug 1877, and died 25 Sept 1935, also in Eureka. Son of Michael and

Edna's older sister, who lived with them for a time. She was either widowed or divorced. She was apparently prone to migraines and "nervousness." She lived at 634 9th Street, Eureka, when she registered to vote in 1934-1936.

Ellery, Velma L.

Killed in a car accident with her husband, William E. Ellery, on 4 Feb 1936. Their daughter was badly injured.

Drowned at Big Lagoon on 15 Aug 1935. Confirmed by California Death Index, 1905-1939.

Fluke, E.G.

Died 12 Jan 1936, per diary.

Forst, Loren L.

Loren L. Frost, b. 26 June 1854 in Oxford County, ME, d. 21 Feb 1933 in Eureka, CA. Buried at Myrtle Grove

Cemetery. Widower of Emma L. Starbird Frost (1856-1922). All information from

Kendel, Henry Henry Kendal, the librarian at the Eureka Free Library. Mary was one of his assistants. Humboldt Historian, Spring

2000, page 5.

Keppel, Mrs. Arived with her friend on 15 Sep 1935.

Lamson, Unknown Went to trial in 1933 and was sentenced to be hung. No first name or mention of what he did, or if he's local or not.

Lawrence, Mr. Died early on 31 March 1936.

Little, T.J. Took family out for a ride on 18 Feb 1934.

Lively, Cecil, Mr. & Mrs. Had the first baby of 1936. Mrs. Lively's first name is Eleanor, and she was a dietician. Cecil worked at a sawmill.

The baby was Ward F. Lively. See 1940 census, https://www.familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:K9Q5-71R

Loretz, Louis I. d. approx. 11 June 1933. "Louis I. Loretz, manager of the F.W. Woolworth store got his neck broken when his auto

went over grade ten miles this side of Crescent City." Age 28 per the California Death Index, 1905-1939.

Lowry, Mabel Had a baby on 9 Jan 1934.

Madsen, Mrs. Edna went to a Sewing Club at her house on 6 Oct 1936. There are several "Mrs. Madsens" in the 1930 and 1940

censuses for Eureka. No indication of who this lady was.

Malone, Mr. Died 28 Feb 1936.

Martin, Dorothy Married in Grants Pass, OR on 15 Sept 1936. Possibly the daughter of John & Emma Martin of Eureka. See 1930

census at https://www.familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:XCF7-8KN Dorothy Elaine Martin married Williard Naylor Nelson on 15 Sept 1936 in Grants Pass, per Ancestry.com. Per the 1940 census, they lived in Eureka and

Maurer, Marie L. Murdered by her daughter, Mabel Maurer Dixon, on 30 March 1933. Widow of Fred Maurer.

McCann, Frank

Same as the unknown Frank who was Mary's beau? Possibly the Frank McCann who was born to John and Annie

McLaren McCann on 6 November 1889 in Humboldt County. California Births & Christenings, 1812-1988. Played

cards with the family on 16 Feb 1933.

McCann, Mabel Tried to get Mary to "go back to" Frank on 2 Aug 1934. Possibly the daughter of Thomas J. McCann.

Meyer, Dr.

Operated on Mary's tonsils.

Miller, John R.

September Memo. "John R. Miller shot Lou Perske this afternoon. Said he did it because Perske was against Roosevelt." There is a John R. Miller listed in the 1922 Eureka Directory as being a mechanic. *If* this is him (it's a common name), was he an employee at Lou's garage?

Mitchell, Mr.

Spoke at a meeting on 12 Nov 1936. There were several Mitchells in Eureka at the time; it's difficult to know which one she is referring to.

Moulton, William

In car accident near Ukiah on 21 April 1934.

Nickles, Mr.

Died in the afternoon of 6 Oct 1936. Found no further information on him.

Noe, Mr. & Mrs.

Hit by a car on 14 Jun 1934 at 4th & J Streets, Eureka. Mrs. Elsnor was also hit. Mr. Noe came home on 18 Jun

1934.

O'Brian, Leo

Drowned while sailing on 11 March 1933.

O'Neill, Hugh

Died 7 Mar 1936. Possibly the Hugh O'Neill who was married to Marion and lived on Williams St. (1930 Census)

Orton, Miss

Died 31 Jan 1925, per diary. Died 5 Mar 1926, per diary.

Orton, Mrs. Owen, Mrs.

A neighbor. Probably Maude Owen, mother of Ralph and Early Owen, per the 1930 census. The Owens moved out

of the neighborhood on 21 May 1934.

Owen, Ralph

Ran into a truck on H Street, Eureka and wrecked his car, per diary, on 21 Jan 1934

Pemberton, Jim

Probably James Wayland Pemberton. See https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/156998106 for genealogical information.

Perske, Louis Emil

September Memo. "John R. Miller shot Lou Perske this afternoon. Said he did it because Perske was against Roosevelt." Perske is listed in the 1930 Census as the proprietor of a garage. He was married to Monnie Perske and

had two children living at home, both of whom were born in the Philipines, when he was stationed in Manila during WWI. He was killed by the gunshot, per the California Death Index, 1905-1939. He was 58 years old and a

WWI veteran. HIs draft card can be seen on ancestry.com.

Petty, Mrs.

Possibly Alice C.G. Petty, widow of Josiah Petty, per 1940 Census.

Pira, Ellen E. She and her daughter were badly hurt in an auto accident on 25 Jan 1935. Died 22 May 1935 per diary. Died in

1935 and is buried at Sunset Memorial Park, per billiongraves.com. She was married to Donald Pira and had two daughters per the 1930 Census. https://billiongraves.com/grave/Ellen-E-Pira/10543946 She was married to Donald

Pira and had two daughters per the 1930 Census.

Poyfaire, Charlott A. Charlott A. Poyfaire, born 1837 (California Death Index). Per 1930 census, she was widowed and lived with her

son, William, in Eureka. She was born in Ohio; both of her parents were born in New York. William was born in

Minnesota. He was a teamster, and was divorced.

Queenie Their cat.

Quinn, Patrick Buried at Loleta on 5 March 1935. Born in British Canada, his parents were from Ireland. He was married to Mary

(born in Texas), and in 1930, they both lived with their son, Owen Quinn. (1930 Census) He was 92 at his death.

Quinn, Unknown On 1 Apr 1935, he decided that two "finks" were going to work.

Shipley, Dean Killed in car accident near Ukiah on 21 April 1934. Probably the son of Harry and Margaret Shipley, residents of

Eureka in the 1930 Census. Death date confirmed by the California Death Index, 1905-1939 database. A computer-

indexed obituary gives a second name in this accident as "Over Cliff," which is likely to be how the accident

happened.

Slaughter, Tom Shot Fred Carter and killed him on 3 Jun 1933. Was tried, then freed on 23 Aug 1933.

Speegle, Mrs. Died on 9 Oct 1935. Possibilites are Cora A.T. Speegle or Amanda Speegle, both of Eureka.

Steinhofer, Ralph Ralph G. Steinhofer was only 25 years old, per the California Death Index. Son of Gertrude J. Steinhofer, who was

a restaurant cook and widow, born in Germany. Ralph worked at a lumber mill (1930 Census).

Steinhoffer, Hannah Probably Hannah E. Steinhoffer, 45 years old and died on July 24th, not 25th, per the California Death Index, 1905-1939. Stemach, Rosie Married 1 March 1936. Rosie was the daughter of Mat and Mary Stemach, immigrants from Yugoslavia, per the 1920 Census. Strain, Josephine M. Died 26 Mar 1935. Probably Josephine M. Strain, 72 years old, daughter of John Strain and Ellinor Ingram. Her death date in the California Death Index, 1905-1939 is given as 25 March 1935. It also misidentifies her as male. Thompson, Robert L. Edna's father. He was a longshoreman, active in the union. Born 3 Aug 1874 per the diary. Thure, Carl Drowned on 16 Mar 1936. Carl I. Thure, per California Death Index, 1905-1939. The California Birth Index gives his birth date as 23 Aug 1932 and his mother's maiden name as Paxal. In the birth index, his middle name is "Vincent." Per the 1930 Census, their parents were named J Otto Thure and Anna E. Thure. They were from Finland. Little John must have made it, because there is no record of him dying soon after. Thure, John Nearly drowned with his brother, Carl, on 16 Mar 1936. Captain Tibbets' death was mentioned in the diary. He didn't live locally, and seems to be a friend or relative. He Tibbets, Alfred D. lived in Alameda with his wife and sons per the 1930 Census. Listed as a Master Mariner, died in Seattle on 12 Sept 1934, due to a chicken bone stuck in his throat.
